SUBJECT: University Of Florida And Crime Stoppers Join To Offer

Reward For Information In Homicide Investigation

NARRATIVE:

The University of Florida, the University of Florida Police Department, and Crime Stoppers have combined resources to offer a reward of up to \$10,000 for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the person or persons responsible for the murder of Sudheer Reddy Satti.

On Sunday, January 04, 2004 the body of Sudheer Reddy Satti was found in his Maguire Village apartment, the victim of an apparent homicide. Since the discovery, UFPD Investigators have been working with numerous outside agencies to develop motive, leads, and suspects. The case is active and ongoing.

Chief Linda J. Stump said, "The department is actively investigating the murder of this young man. We hope anyone with information that can assist our investigation will come forward." The UFPD Criminal Investigations Division continues seeking information regarding these items missing from Mr. Sudheer's apartment...
